Race report

A very hot day, with temperature rising up to 34 °C, had a say in today's result. Alexis Masbou had to ask for medical treatment, yesterday afternoon. The Frenchman, who crashed on qualifying, was diagnosed a fractured 4th finger in the left feet. He tested his fitness in Sunday morning warm-up and, after just three laps, he - in accord with his team - decided to retire. It was not the pain itself that worried the Frenchman, but a general bad condition, probably consequence of the crash, and made worse by the hot weather.

His Italian team-mate was suffering from a virus attack that produced high fever, throat pain and a cold. He took part in the race, but in a condition far from the best one.

Jonas Folger: "A very good start, in which I made up a few positions. Very soon, unfortunately, I began to experience a problem - when braking, the rear went up, the bike was nervous and I could not get all the power out of it. This is the bad chapter. The good one is that I got a pretty good final position, and a few good points. We can do well in Misano".

Luca Marconi: "I had a decent start, and could manage a good race for the first laps. Then, I felt so week - this was a weather condition in which probably also the most fit colleagues had to struggle - that I was forced to slow down, without any possibility to fight for a better position".
